ROYAL ADELAIDE SHOW TO HOST FPV DRONE RACING WORLD CUP

The 2017 Royal Adelaide Show FPV Championship has now been included on the 2017 FAI World Cup calendar, making it the first Australian drone racing event to be included on the world circuit and one of only 15 events internationally to be given this status.

The certification handed down by Federation Aeronautique Internationale (FAI), the governing body for World Air Sports, means all competitors entered in the 2017 Royal Adelaide Show FPV international contest are eligible for the World Cup.

Neil Tank, President of the Model Aeronautical Association of Australia (MAAA), says it's great the Adelaide event can host the highest level of competition in the sport.

"Drone racing is rapidly becoming a popular sport and competition activity and the Royal Adelaide Show will be the first World Cup event conducted in the southern hemisphere," Mr Tank said. "The first FPV Drone Racing Championship conducted at the Royal Adelaide Show in 2016 was a huge success and we are privileged that this year's event has been recognised by the FAI by the awarding of World Cup status."

Last year's event attracted 30 entrants, including interstate competitors from the ACT, New South Wales, Queensland, Victoria and, Western Australia.

"By having this status and being included in the World Cup calendar opens the potential for South Australia to see some of the best FPV Drone Racing pilots in the world. During each race throughout the event, competitors scores are aggregated to decide the winner. The event can only get bigger and better."

Chief executive of the Royal Agricultural & Horticultural Society of South Australia Mr John Rothwell said the Society was thrilled to be hosting a World Cup event.

"Staging competitions is at the core of the Society's charter and the level of competition at the Royal Show is coveted across many industries. To have a competition recognised at this level is a great outcome for the Drone competition at the Show and we look forward to presenting this to both the competitors and the public," Mr Rothwell said.

You are invited to compete. **Please note** an entry will only be accepted on receipt of a complete and signed entry form and the required fee. Please note entries to be sent to Peter Leaney and entry fees to the MASA Treasurer as detailed on the form.

Five classes of racers will be flown GOLDEN ERA Inline, GOLDEN ERA Radial, RENO, FORMULA 1 and AT-6. There will be close scrutiny of models to enforce construction rules, if you have any doubts or questions please do not hesitate to contact the committee for clarification.

Complete rules for 2017 are available on the following web sites, <u>www.masa.org.au</u> and <u>www.cmfc.asn.au</u>.

Pilots (or team entry) may enter up to 5 classes; there is a flat \$60 entry fee which covers all classes entered. Reserve models may be used and are not required to be of the same design but must be processed.

This year's Leo O'Reilly Memorial Concours Trophy will be presented to the team with the best combination of period dress and model presentation. A diorama or photographic display depicting your aircraft in its normal operating environment would attract the judge's attention. Judging will occur during normal racing from Saturday to Sunday and the winner announced at the award ceremony on Sunday. Here is a site to give you some ideas https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Diorama

Pilots must have MAAA Gold Wings endorsement and all aircraft irrespective of weight must have a "Permit to Fly", valid at least 21 days before the event. Entrants will be required to make a declaration that they have flown the aircraft for at least 6 flights before the event.
