Jeremy received his Fine and Performing Arts degree with a Theatre Arts major and a performance emphasis from the University of Nebraska–Lincoln, and was awarded the top scholarship among actors at UN-L for two consecutive years. After an *Augustinian*-like conversion of heart during this time, Jeremy forfeited his scholarship in order to focus more time and energy on growing in his relationship with Jesus Christ.

Upon graduating from UN-L, Jeremy spent a year in the Catholic seminary after which time he spent two years as the Director of Youth Ministry for a parish in Lincoln, NE. In June of 2003, Jeremy started Epiphany Studio Productions as a means of combining his passion and love for the Catholic faith with his passion and talents in the theater. He has since performed his original dramas for tens of thousands of people in the U.S. and Canada as well as two International World Youth Days overseas. His plays have also been viewed by countless others on the global television network, EWTN.
