1.2.2. Storage

Ankara

There are two warehouses in Ankara.

1. One owned and operated by Customs Directorate. Unreleased goods are stored in the Customs warehouse for a period of 20 days. In this period the goods will be liable for seizure and may be sold at public auction. In case of application to the Customs Authorities this period can be extended.
2. One owned and operated by Turkish Airlines. Uncleared goods are stored for a period of 20 days. In this period, consignee or his broker must give declaration to the Customs Authority for providing an unlimited time for storage. Otherwise, goods will be liable for seizure and may be sold at public auction. (For detailed information, please see 8.3. Information by Carrier, Turkish Airlines)
3. There are also special warehouses (Expeditors, Hitiitrans, Sistem Lojistik).

Antalya

There are two warehouses in Antalya.

1. Warehouse owned and operated by Turkish Airlines:
 - Uncleared goods are stored in Turkish Airlines Customs Temporary for a period of 20 days. In order to extend this period, consignee or his broker may give a declaration for time extension to the custom for a limited time. Otherwise, the goods liable for seizure and may be sold at public auction. (For detailed information, please see 8.3 Information by Carrier, Turkish Airlines)
 - Cold Storage: Available, limited capacity: 147 m³, between 0-10 centigrade degree, door sizes: 250 x H:220 cm.
 - Room for radio-active material: Not available
 - Safes for valuables: Not available
2. Warehouse operated by Sistem Lojistik:
 - Uncleared goods are stored for a period of 20 days. In order to extend this period, consignee or his broker may give a declaration for time extension to the custom for a limited time. Otherwise, the goods liable for seizure and may be sold at public auction
 - Cold Storage: limited capacity: 105 m³, between -18 - 0 centigrade degree,
 - 75 m³, between +2 - +8 centigrade degree
 - Room for radio-active material: Not available
 - Safes for valuables: Not available

*) Return of Unclaimed cargo

To return cargo to the station of origin the consignee is to prove that no funds have been transferred for the purchase of the goods in question, against which the Customs office at the airport will grant a Loading Permit.

Due to Customs regulations it is not possible for the carrier to return unclaimed goods without this permit.

TK has special applicatory convenience for Human Remains. Please see 8.3 Information by Carrier, Turkish Airlines.

Antalya

Shipments may be cleared by the consignee or his legal customs broker.

Monday through Friday 09.00 - 12.00 hrs. and 13.00 - 16.30 hrs.

Saturday and Sunday and national holidays closed. Clearance outside Customs hours for diplomatic purchase, urgent medicines, live animals and other goods of an urgent nature, possible after previous arrangements with Customs.

Antalya

● Monday through Friday 09.00 - 12.00 and 13.00 - 17.00 hrs.

● Saturday, Sunday and national holidays closed.

● Clearance is possible on weekends if you have a written permit from customs authority (to be realized within working hours).

● Clearance outside of Customs hours is only possible after previous arrangements with Customs.

Istanbul

Monday through Friday 09.00 - 12.00 hrs. and 13.00 - 16.30 hrs.

Monday through Friday 09.00 - 12.00 hrs. and 13.00 - 17.30 hrs. in summer time.

Saturday, Sunday and national holidays closed.

Clearance outside Customs hours possible for perishables, live animals, urgent medicines and other goods of an urgent nature, after previous arrangements with Customs. (Newspapers and magazines included).

1.2.5. Delivery

Possible at the airport only during Customs hours.

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1.2.6. (Re)-Forwarding

Adana, Ankara, Antalya, Istanbul, Izmir

Goods consigned to destinations other than the point of landing within Turkey: Re-forwarding by air permitted only to international airports. Re-forwarding by surface or ship in bond also permitted, but only by pre-arrangement with the Customs authorities.

2. Import

2.1. General

2.1.1. Packing

Disinfection Certificate when used sacks, hay or straw are used.

2.1.2. Marking

All packages in a consignment have to be marked with consignee's name and address, and must show country of origin.

2.1.3. Routing

- Via Ankara no re-forwarding possible. Consignments to destinations other than Istanbul must be routed via Istanbul.
- Cargo arriving by Turkish Airlines and destined for points other than the point of landing shall be carried to its destination without delay.
- Antalya Airport (AYT) has a first class customs status but no specialized customs zone. Thus, there are restrictions on specific imports (textiles, petrol, chemicals, etc.) to observe. Please coordinate any specific request with customs.

2.1.4. Language on documents

English.

2.1.5. Other requirements

AWB/HAWB: must show full name, telephone number or e-mail address of consignee and notify address of ultimate consignee, VAT number of ultimate consignee and HS Code(s) of shipment. Turkish Customs authorities insist on receiving the original AWB. Therefore on arrival the AWB should consist of at least two original copies plus four supplementary copies, otherwise cargo transfers shall not be accepted for carriage by THY. Goods that have already arrived in Turkey can not be cleared or re-forwarded unless these requirements are met.

Consolidation: in case of consolidation, it should be mentioned on the AWB, "Nature and Quantity of goods" box as follows:

Consolidation; House Air Waybill and cargo manifest is attached. Turkish Customs authorities does not release the cargo unless this phrase is mentioned.

2.2. Documentary Requirements

2.2.1. Commercial consignments

- 7 Commercial Invoices, (one to be certified by local Chamber of Commerce) containing the same information as mentioned on the Certificate of Origin, and the additional declaration: "Nous certifions que cette facture est authentique et qu'elle est la seule émise par notre maison pour les marchandises y mentionnées".
- 3 Certificates of Origin, (issued by local Chamber of Commerce) containing: method of payment, number of reference of Letter of Credit, name and address of the issuing bank, numbering, marking, kind and quality of packages, net and gross weight, terms of delivery, country of origin.
- Import Licence for all goods.
- Certificate of Insurance, not required when the amount insured and the letter of the requested condition has been inserted on the face of the AWB.
- 6 Packing Lists, containing: weight, contents and value detailed for each package.
- A. TR.1-Certificate for goods from EU countries and subject to preferential duties.

The Certificate of Origin together with the certified Commercial Invoice must be submitted to Consulate for legalization.

2.2.2. Sample consignments

For commercial samples:

Value USD 1500.00 or less: Pro Forma Invoice.

Value over USD 1500.00: See 2.2.1.

Except those without commercial value, all samples (incl. advertising material) are subject to normal import duties, but may temporarily be imported after paying a deposit which will be refunded upon re-exportation within 6 months.

2.2.3. Gift consignments

No documents required for gifts if value does not exceed EUR 255.65 (included), gifts exceeding this amount are subject to duty. It is suggested that nature of goods as "gift" be written on package.

Important note: Gifts must be shipped 15 days before or after Christmas, Kurban or Ramazan Religious holidays.

2.2.4. Unaccompanied baggage

Shipments containing radios, electronics, video cameras, computers, etc. will not be accepted as personal effects and can be Customs cleared only when these goods are registered in the passport and/or until the consignee has received his residence permit in Turkey. For new items, value will be fixed at the discretion of Customs. Used personal belongings are generally admitted free of duty. Customs clearance cannot be effected outside the official Customs hours.

2.3. Restrictions

2.3.2. Live animals

1. Non-commercial consignments (Cats, Dogs, Ferrets and Birds):
 - Official Health Certificate 48 hours before departure.
 - Microchipping (microchip date before last rabies vaccination is recommended).
 - Blood test results: 30 days after last rabies vaccination. Then, 90 days waiting period from the date of blood sample. If blood test is not provided (or available) and 90 days waiting period is not completed, animal will be placed in 90-day "Home Quarantine" at the owner's permanent home address. Quarantine period starts from the first visit of veterinarian to the premises. Within this period, owner must complete the blood test formalities locally. Blood test validity is one year only and must be provided by certified laboratory. Rabies vaccination period is one year only.
 - Owner should be travelling on the same flight & date or should enter Turkey not more than 90 days after pet's arrival.
 - Only two pets per person are allowed.
 - Puppies and kittens less than 4 months old are not allowed.
 - Animal rooms are available, but animal hotel is not available. Same day clearance depends on the arrival time & day.
 - The following dog breeds are not allowed to enter Turkey: Pit-Bull Terrier, Japanese Tosaya, Dogo Argentino, Fila Brasileiro, Staffordshire, Roman Fighting Dog, Bandog Tosa Inu, Mastiff, Tibetan Mastiff and similar dangerous breeds or mix breeds of such.
2. Commercial consignments are subject to pre-approval from The Ministry of Food, Agriculture and Livestock.

2.3.3. Plants and plant material

Health Certificate and 2 Certificates of Origin.

2.3.4. Arms, ammunition and explosives

May only be imported by the Government, except when for hunting purposes provided an Import Permit from the Ministry of Defence has been obtained.

2.3.5. Narcotics and drugs

Importation only for scientific purposes. Prior authorization of the Ministry of Health.

2.3.6. Human remains

Embalming report; Certificate of Transportation (to state the cause of death); Death Certificate issued by Turkish Consulate or Embassy. The documents mentioned above should be original; no copies accepted.

All reports and documents should be declared within the airwaybill which are legalised by the Turkish representation in the country where death took place.

2.3.7. Pharmaceutical and chemical products

Import Permit from the Ministry of Health.

2.3.8. Medicines and vaccines

Import Permit from the Ministry of Health.

2.4. Prohibitions

Shipper should contact Consulate for more detailed information.

3. Transshipment/Transit

3.1. General

- The final destination must be shown on all packages or labels.
- All shipments must be accompanied by at least 6 copies of the AWB.
- All transiting cargo carried to destination without delay and with no transit formalities if arrived and re-forwarded by THY, however some minor Customs formalities exist when brought or sent by other carriers.

3.4. Prohibitions
