- II. To keep the Fire Service community informed on Associational operations and activities since we believe that teamwork and communications are essential for the associational objective to promote our profession.**

- IV. To provide a certified annual audit of all Associational income, expenditures and investments**
- V. To set up and follow a budgetary expense for Association income and expenditures**
