The "C. H. Wofford Commemorative Award"*

The C. H. Wofford Commemorative Award has been established to recognize fire departments across the great state of Georgia for their years of dedicated service to the communities they serve.

C. H. Wofford, Retired Atlanta Fire Department, and Retired Executive Director of the Georgia State Firefighters Association, gave a lifetime of dedication and unselfish service to the betterment of the fire service throughout Georgia. It is because of the efforts of C. H. and other pioneers that the fire service in Georgia is what it is today.

The C. H. Wofford Commemorative Award may be received by any recognized fire department within the State of Georgia, upon reaching their 25th Anniversary of existence and upon attainment of each twenty-fifth anniversary thereafter (25, 50, 75, etc.) This Award will not retrogress to honor milestones past, but will honor these accomplishments from 'x' month, 'x' day, 200 and forward.

This Award is to be presented by representatives of the Executive Board of GSFA, and the Chief Executive Officer of the organization, to the chief, their staff, and all members of the recognized department in appropriate ceremonies before their governing authority (city council, county commissioner).

It is the mission of the Georgia State Firefighters Association to serve, promote, advocate, and represent the interest of the fire, rescue, and emergency services of Georgia, and this Award supports the mission of the Association and its commitment to its membership.
