

### RELEASE OF LIABILITY, PHOTO RELEASE, AND CONSENT TO MEDICAL TREATMENT

1. Release of Liability. I, for myself, my minor child and for the child's other parent and/or guardian, hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue North Lanier Baptist Church, and its officers, directors, employees, agents, volunteers, heirs and assigns of and from all liability, loss, claims, demands, possible causes of action, court costs, attorneys' fees and other expenses arising from any lawsuit that may otherwise accrue from any loss, damage or injury to my child's person or property in any way resulting from or connected with my child's attendance at Awana, including, without limitation, the failure of anyone to enforce rules and regulations, failure to make inspections, or the negligence of other persons.

2. Photo Release. I give permission for my child's photo, which may be taken during the week, to appear in any Awana newsletter or brochure used by North Lanier Baptist Church or online at www.northlanier.org.

3. Consent to Medical Treatment. In the event my child becomes ill or injured, I give my permission for a representative of North Lanier Baptist Church to take whatever steps are reasonably necessary to render emergency first aid to my child. I also consent to such emergency medical treatment as may be reasonably necessary to insure the health and welfare of my child including, but not limited to, x-rays, anesthetic, medical or surgical diagnosis and treatment, hospital care and administration of drugs or medicine under the care of a licensed physician and/or surgeon.

4. Awana Contact Permission Authorization. Occasionally your child's handbook leader would like to contact you and your child to see how they are enjoying club and if they need any help in completing their handbooks. Your child's handbook leader would also like to send written correspondence such as "Get Well" cards and a "Birthday Card." By signing below you are giving your child's handbook leader written permission as the legal parent/guardian to contact you and your child, by written communication and by telephone to discuss club activities.

Awana is divided into specific age groups. Puggles are young preschoolers aged two to three, Cubbies are preschoolers aged three and four, Sparks are children in grades Kindergarten, First, and Second, and Truth in Training (T&T) are children in grades Third through Sixth.

(Older students, 7th thru 12th, can continue in Awana by individual study through C-track. Please contact us if interested)

Awana is full of fun events like wild and crazy theme nights and celebrations. Plus, special events, like the Awana Grand Prix and the Awards Ceremony. We have contests to help keep the goals of handbook completion and missions' emphasis before us. We also have Parent Nights for each club.

# **About Awana**

Awana stands for Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed which comes from 2 Timothy 2:15: "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth."

Each week the clubbers will participate in three general activities:

- Game Time: stressing healthy competition with emphasis on having fun and good sportsmanship—win or lose!
- Council Time: teaching from God's word in a way that is fun and relevant to the children's lives!
- Handbook Time: consists of time spent where clubbers recite Bible verses from their handbooks (memorized at home during the week)

We meet Wednesday nights at NLBC from 6:30-8 pm. Many evenings have special themes to make the night more exciting and fun for the clubbers. Enclosed is the 2015-16 calendar that lists the theme nights.

There is a special Awana uniform that your child will earn and should wear every Wednesday night. We also ask that clubbers wear tennis shoes for Game Time. Please no sandals or Crocs.

Dues are \$32 (which comes to \$1 per week) and there is a \$5 registration fee per child. After clubbers complete the entrance book, they become official members and are eligible to purchase their uniform and handbook (see attached price list). All merchandise can be obtained from your club director. If financial situations are prohibiting you from enrolling your child(ren) in Awana, please contact me for a scholarship application. We want all children to attend Awana and learn of God's love for them!

We believe in positive discipline. Children will learn by example through their leaders and teachers. We always try to praise their good behavior. However, not all behavior is good behavior. When a child struggles with disruptive, disrespectful, or dangerous behavior, we have a protocol we follow. If the child's leader determines that the issue cannot be resolved by simple methods, the leader will "count" warnings to the child. "One" is a warning that the next offense will bring greater consequences.

If the behavior continues and the child gets "Two" they will be taken to the club director for counseling. You as a parent will be notified of the behavior and consequences. If the clubber continues to disrupt the group, the clubber will be placed on "Three" at which point you will be called to come pick up your child for the evening. The following week you will need to attend the club meeting with your child.
