Mr. Bruce Rippe, Romweber Flats Developer, came before council with a presentation on his proposed project for renovating part of the Romweber Furniture Building into senior housing (54-Unit St. Claire Apartments LLC) as Phase 1 of the Romweber Flats Plan. Mr. Rippe primarily asked for council's approval to submit the plan to the Indiana Housing Community Development Authority to see if he would be eligible for \$10,000,000.00 in credit loans. Council decided that due to questions and concerns additional discussions and or approval will be decided at a special council meeting schedule on 6/20/2011 at 10:30 AM in the memorial Building.
