Robert Narwold made a motion, seconded by Brad Dreyer, to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. All ayes so passed.

Gene Lambert made a motion, seconded by Herman Struewing, to primarily adopt Ordinance # 12-2011, amending chapter 78 of the municipal traffic schedule at the intersection of Belmont Place & Arlington Drive, making it a multi-way stop intersection. All ayes so passed.

Brad Dreyer made a motion, seconded by Edwin Hunter to formally adopt Ordinance #11-2011; amending the sign ordinance. All ayes so passed.

Gene Lambert made a motion, seconded by Robert Narwold, to Primarily Adopt Ordinance # 9-2011; amending the City of Batesville Indiana, personnel policy hand book concerning overtime and compensatory time for firefighters. All ayes so passed.

Robert Narwold made a motion, seconded by Herman Struewing, to amend Resolution # 8-2010, clarification of Resolution # 8 -2010 approving a statement of benefits & establishing a period for tax abatement for Park Ave. Realty, LLC. All ayes so passed.

Gene Lambert made a motion, seconded by Brad Dreyer, to approve a request from the Parks & Recreation Dept. and a recommendation from "Friends of Brum Woods" for permission to use approx. \$74,000.00 from the principal amount of monies within the Brum Woods Funds per Ordinance # 20-2008. These funds would be used for installing blacktop on trails #1 of the existing trail called "Lena's Nature Trail (.56 miles). All ayes so passed.

MYC representative, Leo Giesey, came before council with an update on their fundraising efforts for the Joplin, MO schools damaged in the recent tornadoes. There group raised \$2200.00 in the most recent fundraiser.

Gene Lambert made a motion, seconded by Herman Struewing, to allocate \$5,000.00 from Belterra Funds to the Prell-Bland American Legion Post #271 building renovation project. As an FYI, the building is located on property owned by the City of Batesville Water & Gas Utility. All ayes so passed.

Herman Struewing made a motion, seconded by Robert Narwold, to allocate up to \$1,000.00 from Belterra Funds for a fundraiser, " Fear Factory Haunted House", located at Romweber Market Place on Oct. 1 & 2 and 8 & 9 to raise monies for Cierra's Club (Cierra Adams) to host safe events for teens. All ayes so passed.

Brad Dreyer made a motion, seconded by Edwin Hunter, to table any further request for Belterra Funds until the October 2011 meeting. All ayes so passed.

Mayor Fledderman commented on the following:

- Thanked the Beautification League efforts planting 100 mums and their fundraising efforts
- Big Four Tavern may need to be taken down due to damage
- Looking into the possibility of K-9 Drug Dog Program
- Radar speed monitor devices may need to be updated soon and /or other purchases

Brad Dreyer made a motion, seconded by Edwin Hunter, to approve the claims as presented by the city clerk-treasurer. All ayes so passed.

Robert Narwold made a motion, seconded by Brad Dreyer, to adjourn. All ayes so passed.
