



Tanzania Vision Trip for Pastors and Church Leaders January 18-28, 2016

(Dates tentative. Trip code MP1601)

ou have an incredible opportunity to see Tanzania's Mara region transformed into a place of hope with self-sustaining communities that have embraced the gospel. Join us in 2016 as we continue to bring hope to Tanzania!

What will we do?

Our focus on this trip is to allow U.S. church leaders to see the ministry opportunities available in the Mara region of Tanzania and discern if this is where God would have their churches partner. This will be an incredible time to see first-hand how impoverished villages are being transformed into Christ-centered, self-sustaining communities. We will encourage and train leaders as well as assist with village outreaches such as hut-to-hut evangelism and medical clinics. At the end of the trip, we will visit the Serengeti National Park for a two day, one night safari where we will debrief before heading back to the U.S. The Serengeti is an amazing place to see God's creation up close!





What skills do I need?

You need to have a willingness to be used by God in another culture. You need to be flexible and able to adapt to the needs and opportunities that are presented to you. Pastors/Ministry leaders may have the opportunity to train Tanzania church leaders.

What about the money?

The estimated trip cost is \$3850*. We will teach you how to raise support through letters and personal contacts, or you or your church are welcome to cover the cost if able. The amount includes just about everything needed for the trip--food, lodging, airfare, ground travel, and travel insurance. Not included are personal items, souvenirs, snacks,

Amsterdam sightseeing, etc. You also will need to bring items for lunch for the days that we are in the villages. The tuition does not include the cost to obtain a passport or any needed shots (Yellow Fever is required). Please note that your deposit is non-refundable, as well as any funds needed to cover expenses incurred on your behalf should you choose not to go. Also, funds donated on your behalf are non-refundable.

What else is needed?

Participants are expected to be team players, refrain from the use of alcohol or tobacco (including electronic or vapor cigarettes) during the entire trip, dress in a way that is respectful of the culture (dresses or skirts for ladies when visiting villages), and submit to the trip's leadership. In addition, participants are expected to complete the training provided for the trip. Training is provided through our website as well as through one or more "live" sessions (virtual or in-person depending on where team members live).

Tuesday—Day in Amsterdam;

Overnight flight to Nairobi, Kenya

Wednesday—Fly to Mwanza, Tanzania; travel to Mara Region

Thursday-Saturday—Village outreaches; leadership training

Sunday—Worship with one of our church plants or partner churches

Monday-Tuesday—Safari

Wednesday—Depart for the U.S.

Thursday—Back in the U.S.
