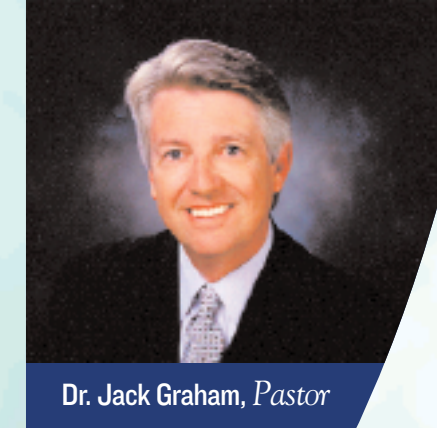
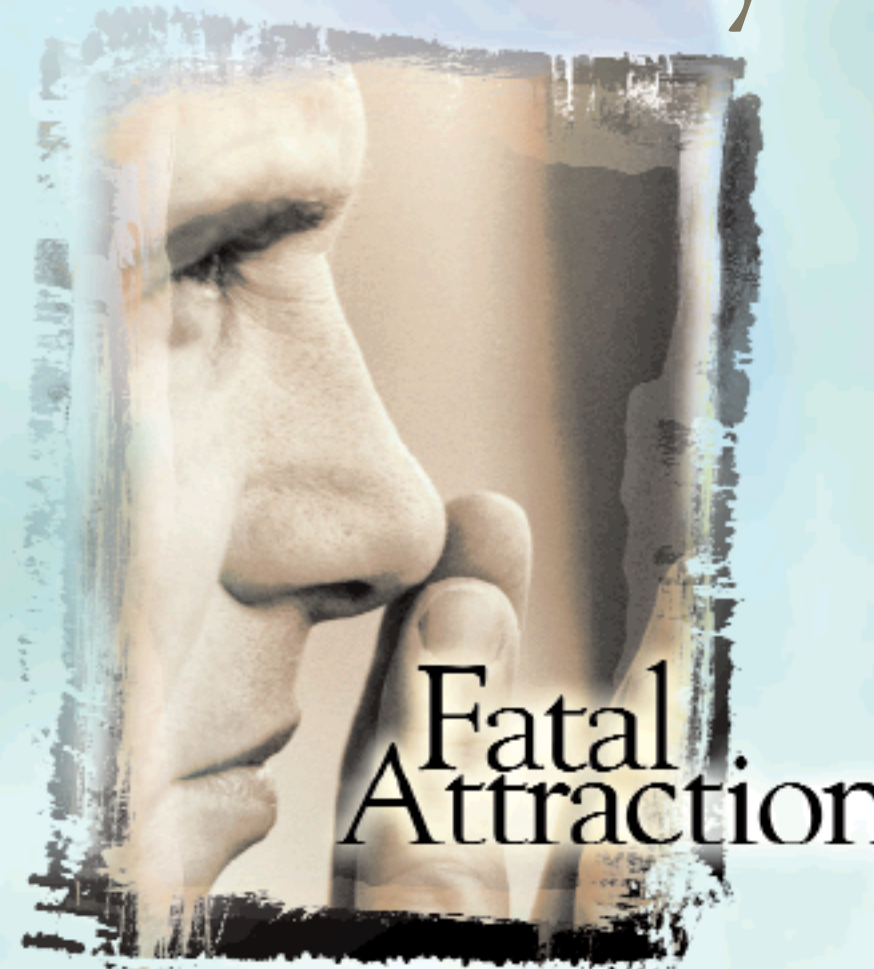

our Purpose in Worship

"Abram dwelt in the land of Canaan, and Lot dwelt in the cities of the plain and pitched his tent even as far as Sodom. But the men of Sodom were exceedingly wicked and sinful against the Lord." Genesis 13:12-13

Today, Pastor Graham brings a message from Genesis 13:1-13 entitled, "Fatal Attraction."

Sometimes, moral compromise can be a dangerously attractive option.

In Genesis 13, Lot chose to dwell near Sodom, although the men of Sodom were known to be exceedingly sinful. This seemingly small deviation from God's will led to great sorrow and heartache. When Lot and his family were eventually forced to flee from Sodom and Gomorrah to escape God's coming judgment, Lot's wife was killed when she looked back and became a pillar of salt. One can only wonder ... if Lot had not compromised when choosing his home, would his wife have lived a full life? Moral and spiritual compromise can have deadly impact - not just on the individual, but on family and friends.
