# REFUND AND LIABILITY

**Refund Policies** Full refunds are provided before program begins. Because of the short nature of the week-long Program, once it begins no refunds will be issued in any amount (except for a medical reason with a signed doctors note). This note must be mailed to the P.A.P office before the end of the program. Refund will be issued pro rata-based on the number of days/hours attended. If note is submitted after the program is concluded then no refund in any amount will be issued.

**Lunch** Each Participant must bring their own lunch as it will not be provided.

**Snow Days** If it snows, the decision to cancel the Program for that given day will be made by Performing Arts Programs, Inc. Snow day(s) will not be made up and under no circumstances will fees be pro rated.

## **Liability Release Emergency Medical Treatment; Photos and Videos:**

Performing Arts Programs, Inc, and the Bushnell and their officers, directors, employees, instructors, contractors, volunteers and agents are referred to as “PAP” in this paragraph. The undersigned, on behalf of himself/herself and his/her minor children named in the above online registration form who is/are being registered for a program/classes (the “Participant(s)”) acknowledge that the Participant(s) may participate in activities involving risk of injury to person or property and they assume full responsibility for all such risk. The undersigned certifies that the Participant(s) is in good health with no condition, illness or abnormality, which might subject the Participant(s) to undue personal risk from engaging in such activities. In the event of any emergency requiring medical care, PAP is authorized to obtain whatever medical treatment it deems necessary or appropriate under the circumstances.

The undersigned on behalf of himself/herself and the Participant(s) (the “Releasers”) hereby releases, waives, discharges and covenants not to sue PAP with respect to any or all liability to the Releasers, their heirs, personal representatives and assigns for any loss or damage and any claim or demand therefore, on account of injury to person or property, including death, whether caused by negligence of PAP or otherwise, while the Releasers are in or about any premises, facilities or equipment used for the program/classes or while the Releasers are engaged in any PAP program or class, without regard to location. The foregoing waiver of liability is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by law and if any portion of such waiver is held invalid, the balance shall continue in full force and effect.

The undersigned gives permission for photos and videotapes of the Participants while participating in the programs and classes to be used for promotional purposes. If you do not wish to give such permission for the use of photos and video with respect to any Participant, you may notify PAP in writing of the same before the program/classes begin, in which event this permission shall not apply to such Participant.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

### **Does everyone who auditions get in?**

Currently we accept everyone until all the spots fill up. As space is limited, we do encourage you to enroll as soon as possible.

### **Does The Bushnell make the decision about who gets in the program?**

The Bushnell provides us with space in which to run the program and has no other involvement. If you have any questions or concerns, you should direct your inquiry only to Performing Arts Programs.

### **What about the staff?**

Our staff is highly qualified to teach the beginner to the very advanced student. Every participant will be placed in a grade/level specific class and get feedback and individual instruction throughout the program week.

### **How do I register my child to assure a spot for them in the program? What is the cost?**

Parents will be able to drop off and pick up their child/children each day for a discounted flat fee of only \$15 for the whole week. ## **DIRECTIONS TO THE BUSHNELL**

166 Capitol Avenue in Hartford, CT 06106

### **From I-91 North & Southbound**

Take Capitol Area Exit 29A. Go straight to the rotary. Go halfway around rotary, and bear right onto Elm Street. Take first left onto West Street. Take right onto Capitol Avenue. The Bushnell is one block on the right.

### **From I-84 Eastbound**

Take Capitol Avenue/Asylum Street Exit 48B. Bear right for Capitol Avenue. At light, turn left onto Capitol Avenue. The Bushnell is one block down on the left.

### **From I-84 Westbound**

Take exit 50, Main Street. At 2nd traffic light, make left onto Main Street. At 10th traffic light, make right onto Capitol Avenue. The Bushnell is three blocks down on the right.

Please enter through the Box Office Entrance on Capitol Avenue.
