In November 1986, concerned Christians answered God's call by establishing the Blue Water Pregnancy Care Center. By then, many young men and women had been convinced that abortion was the best solution to their crisis pregnancies. For twenty years, volunteers have been speaking God's truth into the lives of confused young people and the results have been amazing!

Abortion-threatened babies have been given life, parents haunted by past mistakes have received forgiveness and restoration, and uncertain parents have been shown effective parenting skills. God continues to increase His good work at BWPC today! Dedicated Christians serve clients daily with truth and hope for their lives. To date, we've served over 3,000 clients!

of the center, we converted to a medical clinic in April 2005. Focus On The Family provided needed expertise, excellence, and an ultrasound system. The Community Foundation of St. Clair County's Youth Advisory Council, along with other friends, funded the hiring, and certifications of nurses. Our annual budget grew from \$40,000 in 2003 to \$153,000 by 2005. Client Services receive approximately 60% of the budget. Operations at 40%, include rent, utilities, fundraising (banquet, etc.), and some wages.

The addition of nurses and ultrasound have greatly increased our ability to serve client's needs.



We empower them to make informed decisions and choose life for their babies. Our client load tripled! We anticipate serving nearly 500 NEW clients in 2008!
