021 – LIVING A PRAISE FILLED LIFE (The Rewards of TEHILLAH Praise, Part 1)

Dear Child of God,

Today, let’s begin to look at the rewards of tehillah .

I want to encourage you to continue praising the Lord until you get into the tehillah realm, the place where praise and worship flows without much effort or struggle; this is the place where the “New Song” is born, where mighty breakthroughs take place, and where great victories are wrought.

One of the most powerful passages of Scripture is Psalm 34, and yet, the tehillah is the key to reaping the benefits promised in this psalm.

Let’s take a look. at Psalms 34:1-10.

- “1 I will bless the LORD at all times;
His praise (tehillah) shall continually be in my mouth.*
- 2 My soul shall make its boast in the LORD; The humble shall hear it and rejoice.*
- 3 O magnify the LORD with me, And let us exalt His name together.*
- 4 I sought the LORD, and He answered me, And delivered me from all my fears.*
- 5 They looked to Him and were radiant, And their faces shall never be ashamed.*
- 6 This poor man cried and the LORD heard him, And saved him out of all his troubles.*
- 7 The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear Him, And rescues them.*
- 8 O taste and see that the LORD is good;
How blessed is the man who takes refuge in Him!*
- 9 O fear the LORD, you His saints; For to those who fear Him, there is no want.*
- 10 The young lions do lack and suffer hunger; But they who seek the LORD shall not be in want of any good thing.” (NASB)*

Here are some of the rewards you can expect when tehillah praise is continually in your mouth.

- 1) A new anointing to seek the Lord.**
- 2) Receiving answers while you are seeking Him.**
- 3) Deliverance from every fear in your life.**
- 4) Learning the reverential fear of the Lord.**
- 5) Deliverance out of all your troubles.**
- 6) Angelic protection.**
- 7) Wanting for nothing in your life.**

I pray that right now as you get alone with God, and begin to praise Him with your lips, that God will lead you into a continual flow of tehillah praise.
