002- THE GOD KIND OF FAITH CHECKLIST (#2) What Scriptures am I standing on?

Dear Child of God,

I trust you have your God given target defined so we can take a look at check point number two. Ask yourself this question, "What scriptures am I standing on? Your target must be supported by God's Word. Heaven and earth will pass away but God's Word will never pass away.

2 Peter 1:1-4 says,

1 This letter is from Simon Peter, a slave and apostle of Jesus Christ.

I am writing to you who share the same precious faith we have. This faith was given to you because of the justice and fairness of Jesus Christ, our God and Savior.

2 May God give you more and more grace and peace as you grow in your knowledge of God and Jesus our Lord.

3 By his divine power, God has given us everything we need for living a godly life. We have received all of this by coming to know him, the one who called us to himself by means of his marvelous glory and excellence. 4 And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature and escape the world's corruption caused by human desires. (NLT)

If you need healing in your body today, find promises in the scripture on the subject of healing. If you need a financial breakthrough, find scriptures dealing with finances. If you need direction in your life, find scriptures on that subject such as Proverbs 3:1-6.

Think about this, God says when we personally get a hold of His promises, He enables us to actually share His Divine Nature! God's nature is never sick, never broke, and never confused.

Get God's Word on whatever subject you need results in today. The name of Jesus is above every name, cancer, debt, etc., but God has put His WORD ABOVE HIS NAME!

Psalm 138:2b says, "*.... for You have exalted above all else Your name and Your word and You have magnified Your Word above all Your name!*"
