003 – THE GOD KIND OF FAITH CHECKLIST (#3) Am I hearing these scriptures right now?

Dear Child of God,

Ask yourself this question, “Am I hearing these scriptures right now?” This is the third thing to check off your list.

Faith is always right now; if it is not right now, it is not faith. Romans 10:17 tells us how faith comes.

17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. (NKJV)

In over 35 years of ministry I have found that many Christians think they are in faith because of a verse they read years ago, or the sermon they heard last month, or the powerful service they were in last Sunday.

While all of these events are certainly wonderful, they are all past happenings.

Faith comes by what you are hearing right now. Before you ever release your faith towards your target, I suggest getting as many specific scriptures as possible, and say them out loud over and over again until faith comes alive inside your spirit man.

Remember, faith never comes by having heard, it only comes by hearing God’s Word right now!

There was a time in my life when my heart would skip beats, which caused me to be so tired most of the time. Then I came across the following scripture in Psalm 73:26.

26 My flesh and my heart faileth: but God is the strength of my heart, and my portion for ever. (KJV)

I cannot tell you how many hundreds and even thousands of times I quoted this verse of scripture until I began to believe it. At some point God literally became “the strength of my heart, and my portion for ever. Today, my heart is completely healed!
