008 – THE GOD KIND OF FAITH CHECKLIST (#7 Have I forgiven every person who has ever wronged me?)

Dear Child of God,

Question number 7 on our faith check list is, **“Have I forgiven every person who has ever wronged me?”**

Some of these same individuals look at me like I can bend the rules in their case because I am a minister of the gospel. I can tell you there is no way to get around this check point, if you want to receive answers to your prayers.

Just take a look at these verses in Mark 11:24-26,

24 For this reason I am telling you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe (trust and be confident) that it is granted to you, and you will [get it].

25 And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him and let it drop (leave it, let it go), in order that your Father Who is in heaven may also forgive you your [own] failings and shortcomings and let them drop.

26 But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your failings and shortcomings. (AMP)

Others I believe get angry with someone else early in the morning so they have all day to carry the offence till the sun goes down so they don’t violate the scripture that says, “don’t let the sun go down on your wrath.”

No, my friend, we as believers must be quick to forgive. The sooner you drop it, you will be that much closer to receiving your target in prayer.
