022 – LIVING A PRAISE FILLED LIFE (The rewards of the tehillah (Part 2)

Dear Child of God,

Today, let’s continue to look at the rewards of tehillah.

I want to encourage you to continue praising the Lord until you get into the tehillah realm, the place where praise and wor-ship flows without much effort or struggle; this is the place where the “New Song” is born, where mighty breakthroughs take place, and where great victories are wrought.

Isaiah chapter 61 speaks prophetically of the tangible anointing that was on Jesus while He was on the earth, and what that anointing would accomplish. Since Jesus declared in John chapter 14 that every person who believed on Him would do the same works He did and greater, we have a right to also par-take of His anointing and its benefits.

With these thoughts in mind, let’s take a quick look at Isaiah 61:3.

*“To grant those who mourn in Zion,
Giving them a garland instead of ashes,
The oil of gladness instead of mourning,
The mantle of praise (tehillah) instead of a spirit of fainting.
So they will be called oaks of righteousness,
The planting of the LORD , that He may be glori-fied.” (NASB)*

God says that part of this anointing is to receive a mantle of tehillah spontaneous praise. This mantle is a tangible cloak of intimate Spirit led praise that will stay on you throughout the day.

Gory to God!

This anointing will bring such a level of stability in your Christian walk that other people will call you God’s oaks of righteousness, those that the Lord planted Himself.

This garment or mantle of tehillah praise will replace any kind of heavy or fainting spirit in your life with a powerful joy filled tehillah praise anointing.

Right now, right where you are, receive tehillah praise. Let that garment come on you that will drive out the enemy from your life.

I pray that as you get alone with God, and begin to praise Him with your lips, that God will lead you into a continual flow of tehillah praise.
