



# WORD BREAK

023 – LIVING A PRAISE FILLED LIFE (The Power of RUWA` )

Dear Child of God,

Welcome to “WORD BREAK” #23, which is designed to give you a nugget from God’s Word to strengthen your daily walk.

GOD is looking for people on the earth who will consistently praise Him.

Today, let’s take a look at a new word called ruwa`.

There is an eighth word that God uses when He wants the volume of our praise to be released at literally an ear splitting level. This is the Hebrew word ruwa`, and is pronounced (roo-ah); ruwa` means to mar by breaking, and to split the ear with sound.

There are certain times and situations in which God desires our praise to be released at the loudest volume possible. There is something that is released into the atmosphere that I believe changes even the molecular structure of obstacles in our path.

God gave such instructions to the children of Israel through Joshua, when they were preparing to possess their “promised land.” We need to understand that the “promised land” is a type of our inheritance in Christ.

Take a look at the instructions in Joshua 6:12-16.

*“12 Now Joshua rose early in the morning, and the priests took up the ark of the LORD . 13 And the seven priests carrying the seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the LORD went on continually, and blew the trumpets; and the armed men went before them, and the rear guard came after the ark of the LORD , while they continued to blow the trumpets. 14 Thus the second day they marched around the city once and returned to the camp; they did so for six days.*

*15 Then it came about on the seventh day that they rose early at the dawning of the day and marched around the city in the same manner seven times; only on that day they marched around the city seven times. 16 And it came about at the seventh time, when the priests blew the trumpets, Joshua said to the people, “Shout! For the LORD has given you the city.” (NASB)*

The word shout in verse 16 is ruwa`.

Now, let’s take a look at the twentieth verse.

*“20 So the people shouted, and priests blew the trumpets; and it came about, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, that the people shouted with a great shout and the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight ahead, and they took the city.” (NASB)*

The first word “shouted” is ruwa`; the second word “shouted” comes from the root word ruwa`, and the last word “shout” is ruwa`.

Just as the physical walls came down when the ear splitting ruwa` shout was released into the atmosphere, walls that you are facing today are also coming down as you release the ruwa` of the Lord.

Right now, release the shout of victory to whatever you are facing! Then, go possess what belongs you.
