028 – DOORS I MUST KEEP SHUT (Part4)

Dear Child of God,

Welcome to “WORD BREAK” #28, which is designed to give you a nugget from God’s Word to strengthen your daily walk.

DOOR #2 — DIVISION

If Satan can’t pry open the **Door of Discouragement** in your life, he will knock on **Door #2 — Division**.

Let’s take a look at what Jesus said in Mark 3:24-25.

"24 And if a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. 25 "And if a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand." (NASB)

Paul under the direction of the Holy Spirit said this in 1 Corinthians 1:10-13a.

"10 I appeal to you, dear brothers and sisters, by the authority of our Lord Jesus Christ, to live in harmony with each other. Let there be no divisions in the church. Rather, be of one mind, united in thought and purpose. 11 For some members of Chloe's household have told me about your quarrels, my dear brothers and sisters. 12 Some of you are saying, "I am a follower of Paul." Others are saying, "I follow Apollos," or "I follow Peter," or "I follow only Christ." 13 Has Christ been divided into factions?" (NLT)

Amos 3:3 ask the following question.

"Can two walk together, unless they are agreed?" (NKJV)

I accepted Christ as my personal savior when I was 8 years old, was filled with the Spirit a few years later, and began ministering in my mid teens. I will turn 51 on August 30th, which means I have spent most of my life in the ministry.

During that time I have witnessed countless times in which individuals, married couples, families, churches, and ministries were completely destroyed because the Door of Division was left open.

For those of you who are married, or ever plan on getting married, you must protect that covenant. Your ministry will never be any stronger than your marriage. The strongest unity on this planet should be between a Godly husband and wife.

What the enemy is after through division is isolation. His design is to pull you out and away from where God has planted you, so he can destroy you, your marriage, your family, your church, your ministry, and your assignment.

What the devil is after is your assignment. Fulfilling your assignment is Satan’s worst nightmare. Don’t let him steal your assignment.

The only way to shut this door is to be so developed in the love walk, that Division has no choice but to completely exit your life. **"Love never fails."** (1 Corinthians 13:8a) (NKJV)

This is such a needed subject, that we will continue dealing with shutting this door in our next lesson.
