029 – DOORS I MUST KEEP SHUT (Part5)

Dear Child of God,

Welcome to “WORD BREAK” #29, which is designed to give you a nugget from God’s Word to strengthen your daily walk.

DOOR #2 — DIVISION (continued)

Today, we are going to continue looking at **Door #2 — Division**.

Division always breeds isolation, and isolation breeds death.

Ephesians 4:1-3 says,

“1 I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, entreat you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, 2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing forbearance to one another in love, 3 being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.” (NASB)

God birthed a powerful teaching series in me called “The Prayers In Ephesians.” This life changing series is available in a nice album that contains 15 CDs. In the course of several months of prayer and study, the Lord gave me my own translation of these prayers; part of the first prayer in the first chapter of Ephesians is pertinent to closing this **Door called Division**.

Ephesians 1: 18-19 are such powerful verses.

“18 That your inner man may fully perceive God’s expected calling for your life, and that you know what is the wealth of God’s inheritance, which resides in the sphere of the saints.

19 So you may know and understand the unlimited and immeasurable greatness of God’s power, that is constantly abiding in you.” (McManus Version)

I trust you are planted in the body of believers that God has planted you in. There are certain aspects your calling and anointing that can only be ascertained by being where God has planted you.

The sphere of the saints is the sphere when God’s saints are assembled together.

Let’s take a look at Hebrews 10:25.

“Not forsaking or neglecting to assemble together [as believers], as is the habit of some people, but admonishing (warning, urging, and encouraging) one another, and all the more faithfully as you see the day approaching.” (AMP)

Division is designed to pull you away from assembling, so that you will fall short of what God has called you to do.

Notice the powerful things that take place only in the sphere of God’s saints.

- 1) FULLY PERCEIVING GOD’S EXPECTED CALLING FOR YOUR LIFE.**
- 2) KNOWING THE WEALTH OF GOD’S INHERITANCE.**
- 3) KNOWING AND UNDERSTANDING THE UNLIMITED AND IMMEASURABLE GREATNESS OF GOD’S POWER THAT IS CONSTANTLY ABIDING IN YOU.**

If the entire Body of Christ across the world could walk in these three areas, we would see a world wide explosion of revival, virtually overnight.

We are still not finished identifying and closing this **Door called DIVISION**, but I want to give you a homework assignment between now and the next lesson. I am going to give you verses 18 and 19 of the first chapter of Ephesians in a fill in the blank confession format. I want to encourage you to say this out loud as many times as you can in a day, putting the words I, me, or your name in the blanks.

That ___ inner man may fully perceive God’s expected calling for ___ life, and that ___ may know what is the wealth of God’s inheritance, which resides in the sphere of the saints. So ___ can know and understand the unlimited and immeasurable greatness of God’s power that is constantly abiding in ___.
