DOOR #3 — DISTRACTIONS (Continued)

Today, we are going to finish looking at the **Door** called **Distractions**.

You must stay in God’s Word to fulfill the Destiny, the Assignment, and the Purpose for you being on the earth at this crucial point in time.

If there is anything, Satan cannot stand, it is you living in God’s Word. So, he will try anything to keep you away from the Word of God.

The fact is that the more of God’s Word you are practicing, the fewer handles, the devil and his demons have to hold on to.

Mark 4:18-19 gives us a number of distractions, Satan will try to use to get you to let go of God’s Word. Let’s take a look at these verses in several translations.

“18 Others there are who receive the seed among the thorns: these are they who have heard the Message, 19 but worldly cares and the deceitfulness of wealth and the excessive pursuit of other objects come in and stifle the Message, and it becomes unfruitful.” (Weymouth)

“18 The seed cast in the weeds represents the ones who hear the kingdom news 19 but are overwhelmed with worries about all the things they have to do and all the things they want to get. The stress strangles what they heard, and nothing comes of it.” (THE MESSAGE)

“18 Others are like the seed planted among the thorny weeds. They hear the teaching, 19 but their lives become full of other things: the worries of this life, the love of money, and everything else they want. This keeps the teaching from growing, and it does not produce a crop in their lives.” (Easy-to-Read Version)

Child of God, there will always be other things trying to get you out of the Word. Make the quality decision today that God’s Word is first place in my life, and He will give me the things. In closing, I’m going to lead you in a confession of faith to shut this Door called Distractions and pad lock it forever.

Boldly say the following!

“I repent for allowing other things to detour and derail me from my assignment. Door called Distractions, I command you to leave my life once and for all. From this day forward I will stay focused on God’s Word and my assignment. I will not allow people to lure me into doing a good thing instead of a God thing. Praise God, from this moment forward, I am on track and on target concerning everything God wants me to do. Door called Distractions, I’m closing you now, and pad locking the door. In the mighty Name of Jesus, you will never open again!”
