

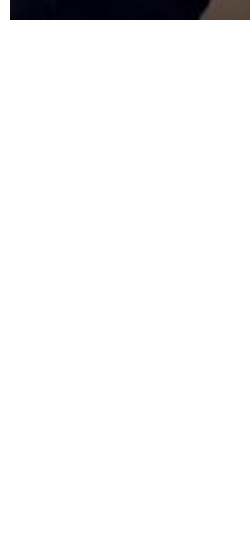

GATE #3 — THE OLD GATE (Continued)

Nehemiah 3:6

“6 And Joiada the son of Paseah and Meshulam the son of Besodeiah repaired the Old Gate; they laid its beams and hung its doors, with its bolts and its bars.” (NASB)

Hebrews 6:1-3

“1 Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment. 3 And this we will do if God permits.” (NKJV)*

Today, we are going to continue looking at the sixth foundational Doctrine.

6) — ETERNAL JUDGMENT

God is just as much a God of mercy as He is a God of justice.

In this session, we are going to look at a number of scriptures depicting **God’s Mercy**.

Psalms 103:8-18

“8 The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and plenteous in mercy and loving-kindness. [James 5:11.]

9 He will not always chide or be contending, neither will He keep His anger forever or hold a grudge.

10 He has not dealt with us after our sins nor rewarded us according to our iniquities.

11 For as the heavens are high above the earth, so great are His mercy and loving-kindness toward those who reverently and worshipfully fear Him.

12 As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us.

13 As a father loves and pities his children, so the Lord loves and pities those who fear Him [with reverence, worship, and awe].

14 For He knows our frame, He [earnestly] remembers and imprints [on His heart] that we are dust.

15 As for man, his days are as grass; as a flower of the field, so he flourishes.

16 For the wind passes over it and it is gone, and its place shall know it no more.

17 But the mercy and loving-kindness of the Lord are from everlasting to everlasting upon those who reverently and worshipfully fear Him, and His righteousness is to children’s children — [Deuteronomy 10:12.]

18 To such as keep His covenant [hearing, receiving, loving, and obeying it] and to those who [earnestly] remember His commandments to do them [imprinting them on their hearts].” AMP

Psalms 102:13

“13 You will arise and have mercy and loving-kindness for Zion, for it is time to have pity and compassion for her; yes, the set time has come [the moment designated]. [Psalms 12:5; 119:126.]” AMP

Psalms 107:1-2

“1 O GIVE thanks to the Lord, for He is good; for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever!

2 Let the redeemed of the Lord say so, whom He has delivered from the hand of the adversary,” AMP

Psalms 108:3-4

“3 I will praise and give thanks to You, O Lord, among the peoples; and I will sing praises unto You among the nations.

4 For Your mercy and loving-kindness are great and high as the heavens! Your truth and faithfulness reach to the skies! [Psalms 57:7-11.]” AMP

Psalms 117:1-2

“1 O PRAISE the Lord, all you nations! Praise Him, all you people! [Romans 15:11.]

2 For His mercy and loving-kindness are great toward us, and the truth and faithfulness of the Lord endure forever. Praise the Lord! (Hallelujah!)” AMP

Psalms 118:2

“2 Let Israel now say that His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever.” AMP

Psalms 119:64-65

“64 The earth, O Lord, is full of Your mercy and loving-kindness; teach me Your statutes.

65 You have dealt well with Your servant, O Lord, according to Your promise.” AMP

Psalms 135:14

“14 For the Lord will judge and vindicate His people, and He will delay His judgments manifesting His righteousness and mercy and take into favor His servants [those who meet His terms of separation unto Him]. [Hebrews 10:30.]” AMP

Psalms 136:1-26

“1 O GIVE thanks to the Lord, for He is good; for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever.

2 O give thanks to the God of gods, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever.

3 O give thanks to the Lord of lords, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever —

4 To Him Who alone does great wonders, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever;

5 To Him Who by wisdom and understanding made the heavens, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever;

6 To Him Who stretched out the earth upon the waters, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever;

7 To Him Who made the great lights, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever —

8 The sun to rule over the day, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever;

9 The moon and stars to rule by night, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever;

10 To Him Who smote Egypt in their first-born, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever; [Exodus 12:29.]

11 And brought out Israel from among them, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever; [Exodus 12:51; 13:3,17.]

12 With a strong hand and with an outstretched arm, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever;

13 To Him Who divided the Red Sea into parts, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever; [Exodus 14:21,22.]

14 And made Israel to pass through the midst of it, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever;

15 But shook off and overthrew Pharaoh and his host into the Red Sea, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever;

16 To Him Who led His people through the wilderness, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever;

17 To Him Who smote great kings, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever;

18 And slew famous kings, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever — [Deuteronomy 29:7.]

19 Sihon king of the Amorites, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever; [Numbers 21:21-24.]

20 And Og king of Bashan, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever; [Numbers 21:33-35.]

21 And gave their land as a heritage, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever;

22 Even a heritage to Israel His servant, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever; [Joshua 12:1.]

23 To Him Who [earnestly] remembered us in our low estate and imprinted us [on His heart], for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever;

24 And rescued us from our enemies, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever;

25 To Him Who gives food to all flesh, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever;

26 O give thanks to the God of heaven, for His mercy and loving-kindness endure forever!” AMP

The **Mercy of God** astounds me. **His Mercy** literally endures for ever.
