## **GATE #3 – THE OLD GATE (Continued)**

Nehemiah 3:6

*“6 And Joiada the son of Paseah and Meshulam the son of Besodeiah repaired the Old Gate; they laid its beams and hung its doors, with its bolts and its bars.” (NASB)*

Today, let’s continue looking at **The Foundation** by continuing to look at **The Office Of The Prophet.**

What does **The Office Of The Prophet** consist of?

**First of all, there are no Prophets in what we call the laity.**

Remember what the instructions were for the Five - Fold anointing oil?

Let’s take another look at Exodus.

Exodus 30:29-33

*29 “You shall sanctify (separate) them, that they may be most holy; whoever and whatever touches them must be holy (set apart to God).*

*30 And you shall anoint Aaron and his sons and sanctify (separate) them, that they may minister to Me as priests.*

*31 And say to the Israelites, This is a holy anointing oil [symbol of the Holy Spirit], sacred to Me alone throughout your generations. [Romans 8:9; 1 Corinthians 12:3.]*

*32 It shall not be poured upon a layman’s body, nor shall you make any other like it in composition; it is holy, and you shall hold it sacred.*

*33 Whoever compounds any like it or puts any of it upon an outsider shall be cut off from his people.” AMP*

The Apostle Paul encouraged the whole church at Corinth to prophesy.

1 Corinthians 14:1

*“Pursue love, yet desire earnestly spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy.” NASB*

The definition of the simple gift of prophecy is found in 1 Corinthians 14:3.

*“But he who prophesies speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to men.” NKJV*

Yet, are all prophets? No.

1 Corinthians 12:29

*“....Are all prophets?....” NKJV*

Ephesians 4:11

*“ And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers,” NASB*

**Second,** what distinguishes between prophesying and **The Office Of The Prophet?**

An excellent passage to give us insight here is Acts 21:8-11.

*“8 On the morrow we left there and came to Caesarea; and we went into the house of Philip the evangelist, who was one of the Seven [first deacons], and stayed with him. [Acts 6:5.]*

*9 And he had four maiden daughters who had the gift of prophecy.*

*10 While we were remaining there for some time, a prophet named Agabus came down from Judea.*

*11 And coming to [see] us, he took Paul’s belt and with it bound his own feet and hands and said, Thus says the Holy Spirit: The Jews at Jerusalem shall bind like this the man who owns this belt, and they shall deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles (heathen).” AMP*

While **Philip The Evangelist** had four daughters who **prophesied**, but **Agabus stood in The Office Of The Prophet.**

**Third,** the **Revelation Gifts** work on a regular basis in someone who stands in **The Office Of The Prophet.**

There are 3 **Revelation Gifts**. What I am going to give here are very brief definitions. If you are interested in a more in-depth teaching on all 9 Gifts of The Holy Spirit listed in 1 Corinthians 12: 8-10, I suggest purchasing my **Bible College level** course on **The Nine Gifts Of The Holy Spirit.**

- 1) **Word of Wisdom** is the supernatural revealing or unveiling the plan and purpose of God, and always has to do with the future.
- 2) **Word of Knowledge** is the supernatural revealing or unveiling of certain facts in the mind of God, and always has to do with the past or present.
- 3) **Discerning of Spirits** is the supernatural ability to see into the world of spirits including God, angels, demons, and human spirits.

I can see, it is going to take us some time to adequately deal with **The Office Of The Prophet**, so we will pick up here next time.
