“DOO-DOO BUSTING” (Continued)

Nehemiah 3:14

“14 *The Dung Gate* was repaired by Malchijah son of Rechab, the ruler of the district of Beth-haccherem. He rebuilt it and set its doors, its bolts, and its bars.” AMP

Another word for **Dung** is **“Doo-Doo”**.

Today, we are going to continue **“Doo-Doo Busting”**.

“Doo-Doo Buster” #3 = WORRY

Let’s take a look at Matthew 6:24-33.

24 “No one can serve two masters. For you will hate one and love the other; you will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.”

25 “That is why I tell you not to worry about everyday life—whether you have enough food and drink, or enough clothes to wear. Isn’t life more than food, and your body more than clothing? 26 Look at the birds. They don’t plant or harvest or store food in barns, for your heavenly Father feeds them. And aren’t you far more valuable to him than they are? 27 Can all your worries add a single moment to your life?”

28 “And why worry about your clothing? Look at the lilies of the field and how they grow. They don’t work or make their clothing, 29 yet Solomon in all his glory was not dressed as beautifully as they are. 30 And if God cares so wonderfully for wildflowers that are here today and thrown into the fire tomorrow, he will certainly care for you. Why do you have so little faith?”

31 “So don’t worry about these things, saying, ‘What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?’ 32 These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs. 33 Seek the Kingdom of God* above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.”

34 “So don’t worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring its own worries. Today’s trouble is enough for today. NLT

WORRY Is Defined As Mental Distress Or Agitation Resulting From Concern That Is Usually For Something Impending or Anticipated.

A Synonym For WORRY Is ANXIETY.

Merriam Webster Defines ANXIETY As Follows:

1 a : painful or apprehensive uneasiness of mind usu. over an impending or anticipated ill b : fearful concern or interest c : a cause of anxiety

2 : an abnormal and overwhelming sense of apprehension and fear often marked by physiological signs (as sweating, tension, and increased pulse), by doubt concerning the reality and nature of the threat, and by self-doubt about one’s capacity to cope with it, care.

WORRY is at an all time high, even among the majority of those who profess to be Christians.

WORRY is a killer!

Here are some things you need to know about WORRY.

- 1) WHAT YOU WORRY ABOUT WILL MASTER YOU.**
- 2) WHAT MASTERS YOU IS YOUR GOD.**
- 3) WORRY NEVER CHANGES SITUATIONS. IT ONLY CHANGES YOU, AND ALWAYS FOR THE WORSE.**
- 4) NEVER VOICE WORRY FILLED THOUGHTS THAT COME TO YOUR MIND.**
- 5) WORRY WILL DIE AS A THOUGHT, IF YOU NEVER GIVE VOICE TO IT.**

WORRY is such a problem among Christians, that we need to spend quite a bit of time on this subject.
