2011 End-of-Year Show- June 18, 2011– 7:00pm Hutto ISD Performing Arts Center “Workin’ For A Living”

Students will be allowed to try on and take home costumes the first week of May as long as all tuition and fees are paid to date so please keep up with all tuition payments. Included in each student’s costume payment students will receive 1 show program, 1 practice CD, 1 backstage helper pass and 1 additional ticket for show. All additional tickets can be purchased for \$5 before April 21st by using the show order form. (do not include your additional ticket in your tally). Order your tickets early! Tickets will be available after April 21st for \$8 and can be purchased during office hours or at the door.

Flower Bouquets are a great way to show your dancer how proud you are of them. Flower bouquets include a carnation and some greenery. Pre-ordered flowers are \$4.00 and include a note with your dancers name. These can also be ordered on the show order form. We will have a limited number of bouquets at show for \$6.00 each so order yours early.

To help our show run smooth and keep our dancers and audience safe, each dancer will be allowed one adult female backstage helper. Mom would be the best, but Grandma, Aunt or family friend may work as well. This helper will be the only adult allowed into the dressing room to drop off, pick up and help your dancer change, as well as the only adult allowed into dress rehearsal. **IMPORTANT!!!** The helper will also need to be available during costume try-on week to help student try-on their costumes and get important instructions for costume, hair and make-up. Please write down helpers name and relationship to dancer on the end-of-show order form.

Dress rehearsal (June 18th) is **mandatory** for all dancers and is a closed rehearsal, which means only dancers, tech people and backstage helpers will be allowed into rehearsal. Students not attending dress rehearsal will not be allowed to participate in show.

A few reminders:

- Students should not be dropped off more than 15 minutes prior to the start of their class as to not be a distraction to other classes.
