





The Feast Before the Fast

In olden days, people would fast – go without food – at times during Lent. Today, many people still go without certain things during this season as a way of focusing their attention on

God. They might go without dessert, eat simpler meals, or not eat treats. Because people would often not eat sweets in this season, they would have to get rid of them beforehand. That meant having a feast!

In French, the day before Ash Wednesday is called *Mardi Gras* or "fat Tuesday." It was a day to use up fattening things in anticipation of Lent. In some cultures this has turned into a great party for several days prior to Lent. New Orleans is famous for having a large Mardi Gras festival every year.

Many countries celebrate *Carnival* for one to two weeks leading up to Lent. One of the largest in the world is held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, where they use the Portuguese spelling *carnaval*.

The English name for this day is *Shrove Tuesday*. Shrove comes from "shrive" meaning to confess. This was the day that you would confess your sins and be forgiven, before going to Ash Wednesday worship services. An important English tradition for this day is to make pancakes as a way of using up all of the sweet things in the house.
