School starts this week! Please visit the youth table to pick up a copy of the home devotional for you to use as your household gets ready for the new school year!

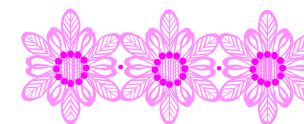

A couple of weeks ago something appalling occurred right in our own auditorium. I came in prepared to worship, and the unthinkable had happened; someone was in MY pew! I hate to call names, (Ty Burnes), and in all fairness, someone else was in his pew, but I couldn't help but be reminded that sometimes we get possessive of "our" space. The last several weeks we've had higher attendance numbers, and I know that what I am about to suggest may be considered heretical, scandalous, and down-right meddlesome, but I think it's important if we want new people to keep coming to church. When we come into worship, maybe, possibly, perhaps, if it's not too much trouble, we might want to think about sitting closer to the front, and scooting closer towards the middle of the pews. If visitors come in late and have trouble finding seats, chances are that they will feel unwelcome, and that is not the first impression we want to make as a family. Today's lesson is all about service. God serves us. We are called to serve others. I hope today serves as a reminder that we should ask God for eyes to see the needs around us and the ways in which we can serve people. It's amazing how something as simple as leaving space for visitors can make a big difference as we seek to put others first.
