Requirements for Consideration

The applicant must be a high school senior of a Lee County based school.

The applicant must be of good moral character and have no criminal record.

The applicant must have a minimum overall Grade Point Average of 2.50.

The applicant must be a burn survivor or the child of a burn survivor / victim.

If there are no applicants of the burn survivor nature, this scholarship shall be made available to the child of a volunteer or career fire service organization member.

The scholarship will be granted in the amounts of \$250.00 for 2-years of college enrollment, or \$500.00 for 4-years of college enrollment.

Applications must be submitted to the Lee County Chapter of the Firefighters' Burned Children Fund Inc. by March 31 of the calendar year for which the scholarship is being applied. The scholarship selection committee will make a final selection and award the scholarship by May 10th of that calendar year.
