

## **DRESS CODE**

As a Christian school, we want to follow the principles of the Bible in our everyday lives, including our dress code. We expect our students to reflect Christ in their dress. For school activities, the student must remember that he or she represents Lee Christian School. The dress code applies as long as the student is on campus or **at school functions** (at home or away).

### **PRESCHOOL--KINDERGARTEN**

- Boys:**
1. Socks and shoes are to be worn at all times. Shoes with laces must be tied.
  2. Dress slacks or denim jeans may be worn (fads and extreme styles are to be avoided). Belts must be worn with trousers that require them and must be anchored at the waistline. No chains are allowed on pants. Underwear must not show.
  3. Knee-length pants may be worn by boys in grades preschool and kindergarten during warmer weather.
  4. Sleeveless shirts or those that expose the torso may not be worn. Shirts with slogans and/or pictures may not be worn.
  5. Hair must be off the shirt collar, above the eyebrows, and no longer than the middle of the ear on the sides. (*NO ponytails!*)
  6. Earrings and facial jewelry may not be worn.
- Girls:**
1. Shoes must be worn at all times. No flip-flops, shower shoes, slides, or clogs may be worn. Shoes must have a closed heel or have a strap around the back of the heel. (Tennis shoes are preferred.)
  2. Dress slacks and denim jeans should be loose fitting. (Fads and extreme styles are to be avoided--no low riders, hip-huggers, etc.) Slacks or jeans must be anchored at the waist--underwear should not show. Knee-length shorts may be worn during the warmer weather.
  3. Dresses and skirts should measure to the bend of the knee in back and the middle of the knee cap in front. Slits in the skirts must not extend above the knee.
  4. Tank tops, backless shirts, shirts that expose the torso, or shirts with suggestive slogans may not be worn.
  5. Blouses must not be made of see-through material. They must have a proper and modest neckline and not fit too snugly.
  6. Facial jewelry may not be worn.

**GRADES 1-5:** Students in these grades **follow the dress code above** and are required to wear:

1. Polo shirts (red, white, navy, black, grey, royal blue, light blue, pink) with the school logo embroidered on the chest. (**NO OVERSIZED SHIRTS**)
2. Slacks may be denim, khaki, brown, olive green, black, or navy. No chains are allowed on pants and no camouflage pants.
3. May wear knee-length pants during warm weather.

**GRADES 6-12 Each article of clothing should be marked with child's name!**

1. Shirts, pants, slacks, skirts and outerwear can be bought from various vendors. If you choose to purchase clothing from a vendor or store, they must be the same style, color, and material as approved by school administration.
2. The shirts must be embroidered with the school logo and can be bought in red, white, navy, black, grey, royal blue, light blue, and pink colors. (NO OVERSIZED SHIRTS).
3. Pants or slacks must be pleated in the front and hemmed in the colors of khaki, navy, brown, olive green, or black. No chains are allowed on pants. (Girls pleated pants are available ON-LINE at Target, Land's End, and Campus Outfitters.)
4. Skirts must be mid-calf length or longer.
5. Boys must wear belts at all times and pants must be positioned at the waistline. Shirts must be tucked in the pants at all times. (*NO sag pants!*) (No chains are allowed on pants.)
6. Boys must wear socks and shoes at all times. Shoes with laces must be tied.
7. No flip-flops, shower shoes, slides, or clogs are to be worn.
8. Shoes or sandals worn by girls must have a closed heel or have a strap around the back of the heel.
9. Boys must be clean shaven at all times. Beards are not permitted. Hair must be off the collar, above the eyebrows, and above the middle of the ear on the sides (*NO ponytails!*) Sideburns must be no lower than the middle of the ear.
10. No head coverings are to be worn in the building (hats, caps, etc.). Bandanas, scarves, wraps, do-rags, sweat bands, etc. are not to be worn to school or at school.
11. Sunglasses and visors are not to be worn in the buildings.
12. Earrings and facial or body jewelry are not permitted for boys. No facial or body jewelry, other than one pair of earrings, will be permitted for girls (*NO tongue or navel piercing or spacers*). *No black nail polish.*
13. ***When outerwear is worn in addition to a uniform shirt, the school logo must always be visible. If you choose to purchase outerwear from a vendor or store, it must be the same style, color, and material as approved by LCS administration. Outerwear must be red, white, or navy. T-shirts that are visible must be red, white, or navy.***

**Anything that the school administration considers to be extreme or inappropriate in hair or dress style for either boys or girls in any grade level will not be permitted. Teachers and staff will determine whether the dress code has been violated. At any time, any teacher or staff member may correct a dress code violation.**
