### Lee Christian School PTF Meeting Monday, September 21, 2009

Mr. Coble opened the meeting in prayer then introduced the guest speaker, Dr. Hall.

Dr. Hall spoke about the concerns of the H1N1 Flu Virus. Handouts were available with the details he discussed.

Kim Womack, PTF President, opened the meeting:

Kim explained that the primary function of the PTF is to be a communication bridge between parents, teachers and ptf board members. PTF responsibilities include:

- Organizing room parents for classrooms
- Supporting special events such as grandparents day and pastor appreciation day
- Organizing Teacher Appreciation Week
- Holding quarterly PTF meetings
- Raising money for the current goal of getting the school a new sign for out front.

On-going Fundraising includes:

**Box Tops:** Stacy Beckner, Box Tops Coordinator, gave an update. We turned in approximately 12,000 box tops last year. Our goal for this year is 30,000! She encourages everyone to participate and start clipping those box tops. It's the easiest free money we could ever earn. Will start to have contests for children.

**Food Lion MVP Cards:** Sindy Horner explained how this works and encouraged that you share your MVP number with the PTF so that we can sign you up for our school. We earn a percentage of overall purchases. Last year we raised about \$35.00.

**Target Visa Cards:** Sindy Horner explained this also. If you have a Target VISA Card you can list Lee Christian school on your account info so that the school receives cash back based on spending.

**Tshirt Sales:** The PTF sold approximately 200 tshirts in April of 2009 and has just placed a new order for approximately 100 Tshirts. These shirts are the Red Tshirts that students are allowed to wear on Fridays instead of their uniform shirts. This fundraiser has been a great success for the PTF.

Upcoming Fundraisers:

The only current fundraiser being worked on is Square 1 Art. Sindy Horner explained that the Kindergarten through the 5th Grade are participating in the fundraiser through their art class with Mrs. Womack. They are creating artwork that will be available to purchase on different gift items such as coffee mugs, aprons, key tags - just to mention a few. Brochures with the products and artwork will be sent home in November. Deadlines are specific and all orders will need to be placed based on the information that will come home. Nursery and Preschool will also be involved in this project but will be organized by Mrs. Hicks.
