The **Ankh Maat Wedjau Honor Society** is a non-secret, non-profit organization whose purpose is the promotion of scholarly study, research, publication and other scholarly activity in the field of Africana Studies among students at academic institutions, and among academic professionals in the field of Africana studies.

Students shall be nominated by a faculty member at their academic institution. The nominating faculty member must be affiliated with an Africana Studies, Pan African, Black Studies Department or Program, or must have a demonstrated record of teaching a significant number of courses that focus on Africana peoples, and be a member of the National Council for Black Studies.

Qualifications for membership are:

- Students nominated must be a major or minor in Africana Studies, Pan African Studies or Black Studies, etc.
- They must have maintained a **3.5** grade point average (or an equivalent letter grade) in their Africana Studies coursework.
- They must have a **3.0** grade point average overall in all coursework undertaken.
- Students must have completed a minimum of **60 semester credits** or its equivalent and have undertaken a minimum of **12 semester units** (or its equivalent) in their Africana Studies major or minor.
- Must complete an application by the deadline submitting the required information and fee.

Nominations are accepted during the Fall/Spring semester and induction occurs in the spring at the NCBS Annual Meeting. Students are required to pay an initiation fee of \$25.00 and annual NCBS membership dues (\$35.00) in order to remain an active, voting member of the Society.
