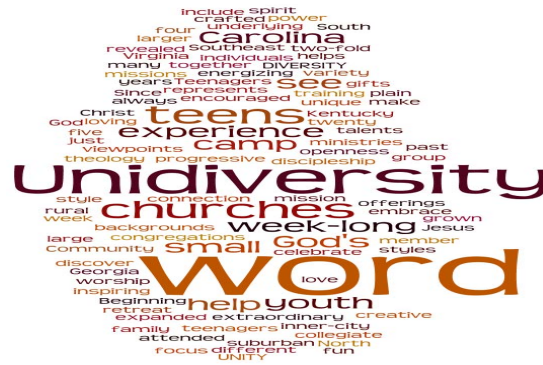




UNIDIVERSITY 2011

When: July 18th-23rd

Depart: Monday, July 18th Depart @ 12 noon (eat lunch before departure)

Cost: \$313 (includes, lodging, meals and whitewater rafting trip)

What to Bring: comfortable clothing, athletic shoes, pillow, Bible, toiletries, pen, sleeping bag or twin bed sheets, pillow, towels, alarm, extra \$30, sunscreen, snacks, drinks, swim suit and fans. Extra shoes for white water rafting. (See Free day activity info on back page)

Dress Code-Campers must be dress modestly and appropriately according to their size and developmental stage, the entire week of camp. While at camp the following clothes are not permitted.

- No short shorts or short skirts.
- No tight fitting clothes.
- No clothing that is strapless, that has low cut necklines, reveals midriffs or is considered low riding or revealing should be worn at any time.
- No shirts with inappropriate language or advertising.
- Tank tops with thin straps
- Thongs or provocative swim suits (modest swim suits only)
