From Scott Hundley, Director of Counseling & Community Life...

This past June I had the incredible opportunity to spend nine days in Haiti with ten other adults from the CCC family. Upon returning to the states, it was extremely hard to explain just how much of an impact the trip made on our team as well as individually. Haiti is by far the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere and is riddled with disease, poverty, hunger, and injustice. In short, we were overwhelmed.

The big question for all of us is "What do we do about it?". However, looking biblically, the question is "What does the Lord require of you?" The answer and the solution are found in Micah 6:8.

On January 9th we will launch our annual six-session, all-church focus titled "**THE HOLE IN OUR GOSPEL**". This will be a probing look at the American Dream and its threat to the call Christ gives us to meet the needs of others. It is our goal that every member, staff, elder and teen accepts the challenge to take a look at the vision God has for us which is likely much bigger than what we have in mind.
