

Pre K-4 Curriculum

Phonics (A Beka):

- Letter name
- Letter Sound
- One-vowel rule
- Read blends
- Read one-vowel words

Phonemic Awareness – the ability to recognize and manipulate individual sounds in spoken language

- Rhyming words
- Sound matching
- Blending

Language/Social Studies/Science (A Beka):

Language development and listening skills that include color words and shapes as well as thematic units (i.e. Five Senses; Community Helpers; Children Around the World; Wild, Wild West) Art projects, crafts and hands-on activities are incorporated to re-enforce the information learned in each unit.

Math (A Beka):

- Recognize and write 1-20
- Count to 100
- Counting objects 1-20
- Introduce the concept of larger and smaller, before and after, more and less, and sequencing events
- Basic introduction to addition and subtraction

Writing (A Beka):

- All capital and lowercase letters
- Some phonics blends and words (i.e. ma, me, mi, mo, mu, nod, hid, pat)
- Journal writing

Bible (BJUP):

- Hymns /choruses/Memory verses
- Lessons:
 - Thinking God's Way: about God's world; about myself; about God's Word
 - Growing God's Way: in obedience; in kindness; in thankfulness; in giving; in work; in trust
 - Knowing God's Way: Jesus is the Way; Jesus is our living Lord
 - Living God's Way: in prayer; in love; in thoughtfulness; in courage; in witness; in contentment
 - Character traits emphasized in application stories that correlate with Bible content
