

## **Payette Lakes Ski Club After School Programs 2009-10 Season**

The Payette Lakes Ski Club will be offering after school programs this year for ages 5-12 **beginning January 5<sup>th</sup>**. The programs will run from 3:45 to 5:00 for **Eight weeks**. We are going to offer a variety of ski and snowboard programs that will accommodate all levels of riders. Come be part of the tradition that has been going since 1937.

### **The ski program and snowboard program**

**Tuesday through Thursday** for skiers and **Wednesday through Friday** for boarders.

The **beginner/intermediate** program focuses on learning the basics of skiing/snowboarding and developing the beginning rider. The **Advanced** program focuses on improving riding abilities and includes introduction to terrain parks, jumping, running gates and riding off trail.

The cost for these Programs is **\$250 Before Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> or \$270 after Nov 1st**. This includes: a season pass, locker rental\*, transportation to the hill, instruction and coaching.

**The Saturday Program** runs from **12:30 until 2:30 p.m.** This program is offered to all levels of skiers and snowboarders. The cost of this program is **\$120**. This includes a season pass, locker rental\*

**For an additional \$25 after school students can participate in the Saturday program**

**Adventure Program** is offered on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. The class focuses on introduction to Nordic skiing, snowshoeing and winter skills such as building snow structures, learning snow safety etc. The cost is **\$125** a limited supply of Nordic equipment and snowshoes are available for use.

### **Scholarships are available in limited amount.**

We will try to accommodate all students interested in skiing. We have a limited amount of scholarship funds for the program and this year some equipment scholarships are available for season equipment rental. If you are interested in scholarships, please include a letter informing us of your situation and we will do what we can to get your child on the hill. **All scholarship letters must be received by Nov 1st.
