



From Fr. Marty dated 2018

How good are you? One of my weaknesses has always been that I've never have been able to love myself. Many of my friends have tried to convince me that I'm loved and loveable, but to no avail. I just can't see it. All I can see are my faults, failures and imperfections, and to me these are glaring.

In this Sunday's Gospel for John, we hear Jesus say, "As the Father loves me, so I also love you." I understand how God the Father loves his only begotten Son, but how can he really love me?

The first reading from the Acts of the Apostles shows us that God loves us. Paul and Cornelius' interaction begins with social propriety. Paul, who has a greater social status than Cornelius, arrives, and Cornelius bows to show his humility. It is Paul, who than takes him by the hand and lifts him off his knees, that helps Cornelius recognize his true worth in Christ! Paul revealed his honor, which the Love of Christ had given him. Although not deserved, it was by Christ's Paschal Mystery of the Cross and Resurrection, that each of us is made worthy to be loved, as well.

We are called to remember this in our interactions with one another. There is a story about a reporter who was invited to the Kennedy Inaugural Ball. It was everything that he expected and more. On his very cold walk back to his hotel, he noticed two young boys standing in a doorway, one was a little older than the other. They looked a lot alike, so he naturally assumed that they were homeless brothers. As he watched for a moment, he saw the older boy take his hat off and put it on his younger brother's head, and then they sat down together, in each other's arms, and the eldest brother took off his coat and covered them both with it.

This is the same kind of love that Christ has for us. We may not believe that God can love us, be he does. "For God so loved the world that he sent his only begotten Son." What God sees in his Son, he also sees in each of us.

God wants us to be willing to receive his love and begin to live with one another in that same love, by reaching out in compassion and forgiveness to one another, as he has done for us. Let us just do one thing this week—and acknowledge that we are loved by Christ.





be looking for craft items, fresh produce and canned produce, so keep us in mind when canning and crafting. Thank You!






