This drive God put in us to procreate is to be exercised in the exclusive, permanent relationship of marriage. As the scripture tells us, they become two in one flesh. In marriage, two people promise God, as well as each other, to take each other as husband and wife, "for better, for worse, for richer, for poorer, in sickness and in health until death."

Matrimony is a communion; a commitment of love whose dynamism is permanent. The demand for mutual happiness derives from there. Therefore, we must encourage and support the couples to live together, and we pray for their healthy married lives. To conclude, it I say whether we are married or not. our major task in life is learning how to grow in love of God and our neighbor. That's what it's all about and that will be our joy in this life and in heaven.




