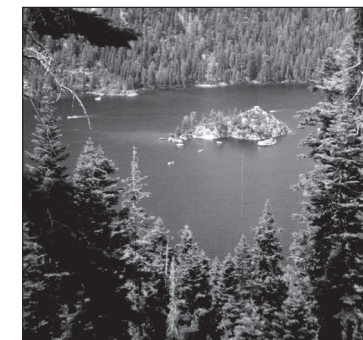
Welcome to our 11th Annual Family Encampment at Historic Camp Richardson, in South Lake Tahoe, California

### MONEY MATTERS!

Adequate finances seem to be problematic for all. Our personal budgets need to be revised often and expenditures have to be reduced. It continues to be our policy not to set a fee for our TFE attendees, as we depend on your generous heart and your desire to see our encampment continue. Two contributions (Sunday & Tuesday) provide opportunities for each person to give as they are able so we can cover expenses. We spend sparingly and no one is paid a salary. Some speakers are provided housing as needed and some help is given to travel expenses when needed. \$4,000 is paid for rental of the big tents, chairs, etc. All spaces required for tents and surrounding area in Eagle's Nest is a fixed camp expense. Fuel costs for moving trailers and supplies, plus administrative costs (paper, printing, program, postage, etc.) are paid from general funds. We take control of all cost seriously. This year with pressing economic strains, we know it is increasingly difficult to give, yet, we hope *each person* will do all possible to meet the needs of camp. *We need your support*; any amount, large or small, will help defray the cost.

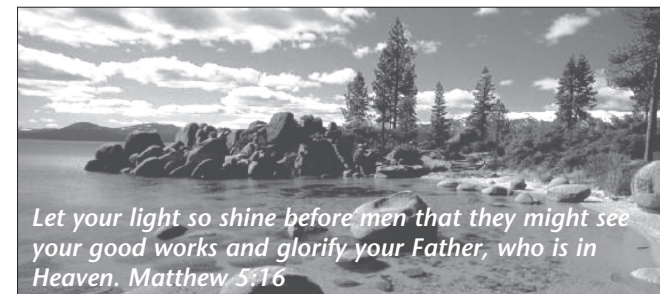
