**Personal Reflection and Application:**

1. Consider how Christ has equipped you during the last months and years that you've been at Oak Hill. Recall particular people and events that have been influential in your faith.
2. Christianity is about a relationship with a risen Savior. We are called to be in relationship with Him and others who are on mission. With whom do you have relationships at Oak Hill that have encouraged you? What relationships with unbelievers have you sought to cultivate?
3. What patterns in life need to change so you have time to do what Christ has called you to do? What passions and desires must be in place in order to have Christ's love for others? Is there something about the gospel you find so difficult to believe that it is stopping you from sharing it with others?

**Gospel Community Discussion Questions:**

1. How has Christ equipped you through your time at Oak Hill? Name specific times, places, and people that have shaped your beliefs.
2. Read Luke 9:3. Why did Christ tell His disciples to take no provisions with them on their journey? What does this look like today when you go on mission with your gospel community?
3. Read Luke 9:5. How were the disciples called to handle the rejection of Christ's message? How should we handle it? What are we afraid will happen if someone rejects Christ's message?
4. Which of the three reasons do you find yourself giving most often to stop yourself from following Christ's commands (time, desire, belief)? How can your gospel community assist in overcoming these excuses?
