ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

In accordance with Section 103 of Article 5-A of the General Municipal Law, sealed Bids for the construction of the Beaver Creek Park Project - Site Work will be received by Town of Farmington, at the office of the Town of Farmington, 1000 County Road #8, Farmington, NY 14425, until 2:00 PM local time on July 22, 2020, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The project consists of the construction of a new park for the Town of Farmington on recently acquired lands within the Auburn Meadows and Beaver Creek Subdivisions. Included in the project are the following; one full size little league baseball field, one full size soccer field, a second smaller soccer field, two tennis courts, one basketball court, two access roads off two existing curb cuts, three parking lots with lighting, five foot wide stone dust trails, concrete sidewalks and curbs, landscaping, fencing and stormwater management facilities. Site work associated with these items includes excavation, grading, backfill, compaction, utility installation, paving, erosion control and restoration. Utilities include the following and their appurtenances; sanitary and water services, storm sewers, underdrains, storm structures, electric lines and communication conduit. The project will have two prime contracts, General Construction and Electrical.

Separate sealed Bids will be received for:

- Contract No. 1 – Contract #1: General; and
- Contract No. 2 – Contract #2: Electrical.

Bids shall be on a lump sum basis as indicated in the Bid Form.

If the CD is to be shipped, the Bidder must furnish Avalon with the Bidder’s active UPS or Federal Express account number or pay Avalon for all shipping and handling costs.
3. For a non-refundable fee, printed copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Avalon Planroom. If the documents are to be shipped, the Bidder must furnish Avalon with the Bidder’s active UPS or Federal Express account number or pay Avalon for all shipping and handling costs.

The Bidding Documents must be obtained through the Avalon Planroom in order to be considered a Plan Holder of record. Bidding Documents obtained from any other source are for examination only, are not considered complete and are not valid for bidding purposes.

Bidding Documents also may be examined at the offices of MRB Group, and the Town of Farmington, 1000 County Road #8, Farmington, NY 14425, on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 9:00 AM and 3:30 PM *by appointment only*; or online through internet based construction information subscription services.

The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Town of Farmington, nor Engineer, nor Avalon will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

The Town of Farmington, Ontario County, NY, reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or to waive any informalities, or to make an award to other than the low bidder. It further reserves the right to limit the amount of the award.

Attention of the bidders is particularly directed to the requirements of the conditions of employment to be observed and minimum Wage Rates to be paid under the Contract.

The Town of Farmington does not discriminate on the basis of handicapped status in admission or access to, or treatment or employment in, its programs and activities.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on July 16, 2020 at 1:00 PM local time at 1000 County Road #8, Farmington NY with a site visit to the Park Project site to immediately follow. Representatives of Owner and Engineer will be present to discuss the Project. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.
