HOOK ROAD AND CURRAN ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS 2018**

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

In accordance with Section 103 of Article 5-A of the General Municipal Law, sealed Bids for the construction of the Hook Road and Curran Road Intersection Improvements 2018 will be received by Town of Farmington, at the office of the Town Clerk, 1000 County Road 8, Farmington, New York 14425, until 10:00 AM local time on March 13, 2019, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

Project includes the following work along Hook Road and Curran Road: Removal of the existing pavement to design subgrade, installation of new base and asphalt pavement, and the installation of storm drainage crossings and road side ditch drainage. Work at the Hook Road and Curran Road intersection includes removal of the existing intersection asphalt pavement and base material, installation of subsoil for grading and topsoil for seeding, the realignment of Curran Road to form a perpendicular intersection with Hook Road with installation of new compacted subgrade to road box, new base, asphalt binder, and asphalt pavement.

Sealed Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum basis as indicated in the Bid Form.

Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM, and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office on or after February 15, 2019, as described below.

Bidding Documents also may be examined at the office of the Town of Farmington, 1000 County Road 8, Farmington, New York 14425 on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 9:00 AM and 3:30 PM; at plan rooms, or online through internet based construction information subscription services.

Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office during the hours indicated above. Bidding Documents are available on compact disc (as portable document format (PDF) files) free of charge. No print documents will be issued. Bidder is responsible for costs associated with printing the Digital Documents. In order for a bid to be considered valid, Bid Documents must be obtained from the Issuing Office only. Bidding Documents obtained from any other source are for examination only, are not considered complete, and are not valid for bidding purposes.

Upon request and receipt of a separate non-refundable shipping charge of \$10 payable to the Issuing Office, the Issuing Office will transmit the Bidding Documents via delivery service. In lieu of the shipping charge, prospective bidders may pick up Bidding Documents themselves at the Issuing Office, or they may ask to have the documents shipped on their own account number. Prospective bidders having Bidding

Documents shipped on their own account number must provide their account number, desired method of shipping (overnight, next afternoon, etc.) and a statement permitting the Issuing Office to use their account number to ship documents to them. Requests for Bidding Documents that are not accompanied by the required letter will be returned.

When requesting Bidding Documents, prospective bidders must include a letter stating their name, firm's name, shipping address (no P.O. Box numbers), telephone number, email address, fax number (if any), name of project for which they are requesting Bidding Documents, intended contract, amount of money enclosed, and, if applicable, check numbers.

The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Town of Farmington, nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

The Town of Farmington, Ontario County, New York, reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or to waive any informalities, or to make an award to other than the low bidder.

Attention of the bidders is particularly directed to the requirements of the conditions of employment to be observed and minimum Wage Rates to be paid under the Contract.

The Town of Farmington does not discriminate on the basis of handicapped status in admission or access to, or treatment or employment in, its programs and activities.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on March 5, 2019 at 10:00 AM local time at 1000 County Road 8, Farmington New York. Representatives of Owner and Engineer will be present to discuss the Project. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.
