In accordance with Section 103 of Article 5-A of the General Municipal Law, sealed Bids for the construction of the Fairdale Pump Station (PS-2) Improvements will be received by Town of Farmington, at the offices of the Town Clerk, 1000 County Road 8, Farmington, New York 14425, until 10:30 AM local time on April 10, 2019, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The project involves the replacement of the existing Fairdale PS-2 Pump Station including, but not limited to the following: demolition of the existing pump station and structure, installation of prepackaged duplex suction lift pump station including electrical construction, instrumentation, controls, general site work, and a gas service installation.

Sealed Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum basis, with alternate bid items as indicated in the Bid Form.
