

## ***News release***

The Town of Farmington's Park Planning Advisory Committee will be holding their second meeting on Wednesday evening, May 27, 2015, commencing at 7:00 p.m., in the Main Meeting Room, upper level of the Farmington Town Hall, 1000 County Road 8.

The Committee will begin to focus on the inter-connectivity of trails, sidewalks and streets to the Town owned parklands within the Auburn Meadows Subdivision Tract, the Estates @ Beaver Creek Subdivision Tract and the future connection to the proposed Monarch Manor Subdivision Tract. In addition, the Committee will be informed by the Town Parks and Recreation Advisory Board of their short term and long term needs for recreational programs and land needs. Finally, the Committee Members will begin work sessions on concepts for parkland layout.

A draft Beaver Creek Park Master Plan, for public review and comment, is anticipated later this fall. Following the completion of that park master plan document, the Committee will then commence the update to the adopted Town of Farmington Parks and Recreation Master Plan. Both documents will serve to guide future park and recreational needs within the Town of Farmington.

The Advisory Committee is comprised of elected and appointed Town Officials, five residents from both Subdivision Tracts, as well as the consultants from MRB Group, P.C., the Town Engineers and Doug McCord Landscape Architects. Ron Brand, the Town's Director of Planning and Development serves as the Project Manager for this park planning program.
