### FINAL ASSESSMENT ROLL - NOTICE OF COMPLETION

Pursuant to Section 516, NYS Real Property Tax Law, the Sole Assessor, Town of Farmington, County of Ontario, NY has completed the current year's Final Assessment Roll, and has filed a certified copy thereof with the Office of Town Clerk for public inspection. Said copy is available for public inspection at Farmington Town Hall located at 1000 County Road 8 during regular scheduled workday hours. Said hours may be obtained by calling the Assessor at (315) 986-8100 (option 4). Pursuant to provisions of NYS Real Property Tax Law, the above notice must be published at least once in the Town's official newspaper and posted on the Town's official signboard. Also, as required by Law, the Final Assessment Roll - Notice of Completion must be published and posted on or about July 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year, after filing a certified copy of the Final Assessment Roll with the Town Clerk.

### SMALL CLAIMS REVIEW - THE FILING OF PETITION(S)

Pursuant to Section 730, NYS Real Property Tax Law, petitions for the review of certain qualifying assessments through Small Claims Procedures may be obtained from the Office of the County Clerk. Such petitions shall be filed within thirty (30) days after completion and filing of the Final Assessment Roll containing such assessment. Detailed filing instructions are contained in the petition form, to include eligibility and pre-requisite requirements.
