TO ALL PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS:

The Town of Farmington, Ontario County, New York (in accordance with Section 103 of Article 5-A of the General Municipal Law) hereby invites the submission of sealed bids for:

Phase 3, 4, & 5 North Road Watermain Replacement

The Work is generally described as:

This project includes the replacement of approximately 4,800 LF of 8" Cast Iron watermain on North Road beginning from just West of Mohawk Road intersection and going to East of Sand Hill Road with 8" PVC DR-14 watermain, valves, hydrants, services and appurtenances.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on September 18, 2019 at 10:00 AM local time at the Town of Farmington, 1000 County Road 8, Farmington, New York, 14425. Representatives of Owner and Engineer will be present to discuss the Project. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory.

Sealed bids for Phase 3, 4, & 5 North Road Watermain Replacement will be received until 10:00 AM Prevailing Time, October 2, 2019 at the Town of Farmington, 1000 County Road 8, Farmington New York 14425 at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

Contract Documents as prepared by MRB Group, Engineering, Architecture and Surveying, D.P.C., may be examined at the following locations:

No print documents will be issued; Bidder is responsible for costs associated with printing the Digital Documents. Bid documents obtained from third parties are considered informational only and may not be relied on as complete documents for use in preparing a bid.

A non-reimbursable charge of \$10.00 payable to MRB Group, D.P.C. shall be made for plans and specifications mailed parcel post to prospective bidders. Prospective bidders may ask to have the documents shipped on their own account number. When requesting Contract Documents, prospective bidders must include a letter stating their name, firm's name, shipping address (no P.O. Box numbers), telephone number, fax number (if any), name of project for which they are requesting Contract Documents, amount of money enclosed, and, if applicable, check numbers. Prospective bidders having Contract Documents shipped on their own account number must also include their account number, desired method of shipping (overnight, next afternoon, etc.) and a statement permitting MRB Group, D.P.C., to use their account number to ship documents to them. Requests for Contract Documents that are not accompanied by the required letter will be returned.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check for an amount not less than five (5) percent of the amount bid payable to the order of the Town of Farmington, or a bond with sufficient sureties to be approved by Town of Farmington, in a penal sum of not less than five percent of the amount bid. If after the Owner's acceptance of a bid, the successful bidder fails to enter into a Contract pursuant to the requirements of the Contract Documents, then the Bid Security and/or the money standing to the credit of the same shall be forfeited to the Owner.
