

**TOWN OF FARMINGTON
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that a public hearing will be held by the Town Board of the Town of Farmington on the 9th day of November, 2021, at 7:00 p.m., at the Farmington Town Hall, 1000 County Road 8, Farmington, New York, to consider proposed to the Town of Farmington Sewer District pursuant to Section 202-b of the New York State Town Law.

The Town of Farmington, on behalf of the Farmington Sewer District, owns and operates sewer facilities and has become aware that improvements, consisting of the redirection of a sewer force main (Pump Station 1 force main) from its current discharge location in the sewer collection system (along route 96), down along the east side of Beaver Creek Road to a large transmission sewer that will free up capacity in the sewer collection system and also alleviate sewer overflows in the Town, which are improvements beyond the original scope of the project, are now necessary, and that the estimated cost for these additional improvements is \$600,000.

As a result, the Town Engineer has prepared a Preliminary Engineering Report dated November 2021, which describes these improvements and shows the estimated cost for all improvements to be \$600,000.

Any resident of the Town of Farmington shall be entitled to be heard upon this matter at such public hearing. Copies of the original plan and the revised plan showing these proposed improvements and the costs are available for review at the Town of Farmington Town Hall, 1000 County Road 8, Farmington, New York.
