ZB #0801-19, FARMINGTON UNITED METHODIST CHURCH, 5925 COUNTY ROAD 41, FARMINGTON, NEW YORK 14425: Request an Area Variance in accordance with Chapter 165, Article V, Section 45 of the Farmington Town Code. The applicant wishes to erect a thirty two (32) square foot freestanding commercial speech sign with moving/motion signage to be located along the southeast corner of the intersection of New York State Route 332 and County Road 41. The property is located at 5925 County Road 41 and is zoned RB Restricted Business.

ZB #0802-19, FINGER LAKES WILDLIFE CENTER INC., 4949 FOX ROAD, PALMYRA, NEW YORK 14522: Request a Temporary Use Permit in accordance with Chapter 165, Article VII, Section 91 of the Farmington Town Code. The applicant wishes to operate an Ecological Visitor's Center with environmental education programs and exhibition of native New York State flora and fauna. Days and hours of operation would be Monday, Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday from 11am to 4pm. The property is located at 4949 Fox Road and is zoned A-80 Agricultural.

ZB #0803-19, FINGER LAKES WILDLIFE CENTER INC., 4949 FOX ROAD, PALMYRA, NEW YORK 14522: Request an Area Variance in accordance with Chapter 165, Article V, Section 45 of the Farmington Town Code. The applicant wishes to erect a 1280 square foot accessory structure in the front yard portion of their lot located at the southwest corner of County Road 28 and Fox Road. The property is located at 4949 Fox Road and is zoned A-80 Agricultural.
