## Hemminger questions on Delaware River project:

- 1. Green Space: I know Jim has two different interpretations. Need to know which one he is going to use and if this project meets the green space requirements.
  - (Flat I calculate 9.6 acres of panels per parcel, they calculate it as 3.39 acres)
- 2. Applications states, "minimal noise and no nighttime noise." How minimal (decibles)?
- 3. Are the deciduous trees what we really want as screening?
- 4. Where will monitoring be performed? What type of internet connection will be used?
- 5. What lighting will be used? Will it be motion activated?
- 6. Verify the modules/arrays will not be cleaned with chemicals, how will they be cleaned?
- 7. Will all damaged modules be removed from the site and all residue from the damage cleaned up and removed?
- 8. Verify that only panels that pass the TCLP test will be used on this project?
- 9. Although I understand that you checked with other land owners, verify that no land owners along the RG&E interconnection area were willing to lease land.
- 10. Appendix I is confusing and raises questions. Although it may meet "EPA Regulations" what are the actual concentrations of waste materials?
- 11. Request photo simulation of view from different angles along both Fox and Yellow Mills Roads.
- 12. Since land will be leased from an "Affiliate of DRS". Who is this affiliate? Does that not muddy the water on a decommissioning plan and the rest of the agreed upon items? Page 2 of Appendix I
