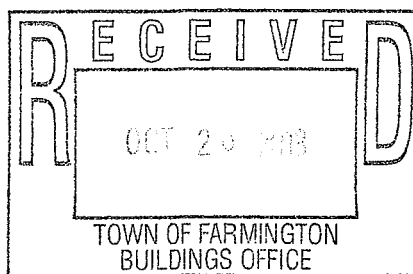

We moved to this picturesque Northeast quadrant of the Town of Farmington 22 years ago and raised our three sons on our 100-acre farm on Fox Road located directly across from the proposed Solar Power Plant. We take great pride in our restoration of our 1842 Historic Cobblestone. Passersby's often stop and ask if they can take pictures of our house. We always oblige and often my husband will give a grand tour pointing out its architectural elements. I mention this to illustrate our commitment to preserving the neighborhood.

The proposed Delaware River Solar Power Plant would be an eyesore, in part because of the chain-link fence, that would be placed around it with minimal landscaping, 24/7 lighting, road glare, etc. And further as there is no real comparable data to prove otherwise, one can assume that this Large-Scale Power Plant will influence neighboring home values.
