FARMINGTON PARKS RESTROOM ADA UPGRADES**

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

In accordance with Section 103 of Article 5-A of the General Municipal Law, sealed Bids for the construction of the Farmington Parks Restroom ADA Upgrades to Pumpkin Hook Park and Town Hall Park restrooms will be received by the Town of Farmington, at the office of the Town of Farmington, 1000 County Road #8, Farmington, NY 14425, until 10:00 AM local time on October 17, 2019, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The project includes the renovation of two existing town park restroom facilities at Town Hall Park (County Road #8) and Pumpkin Hook Park (Allen Padgham Road), which are 4.5 miles from one another. The work shall include minor interior demolition, new walls and ceilings, new plumbing fixtures and toilet partitions, new lighting, new interior finishes and paint, new doors and frames and new exterior concrete pads.

Sealed Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum basis, as indicated in the Bid Form.

In accordance with Section 101.5. of Article 5-A of the General Municipal Law, Bidders shall submit with its bid a separate sealed list that names each subcontractor that the bidder will use to perform work on the contract, and the agreed-upon amount to be paid to each, for: (a) plumbing and gas fitting, (b) steam heating, hot water heating, ventilating and air conditioning apparatus and (c) electric wiring and standard illuminating fixtures.

3. For a non-refundable fee, printed copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Avalon Planroom. If the documents are to be shipped, the Bidder must furnish Avalon with the Bidder’s active UPS or Federal Express account number or pay Avalon for all shipping and handling costs.

The Bidding Documents must be obtained through the Avalon Planroom in order to be considered a Plan Holder of record. Bidding Documents obtained from any other source are for examination only, are not considered complete and are not valid for bidding purposes.

Bidding Documents also may be examined at the offices of MRB Group, and the Town of Farmington, 1000 County Road #8, Farmington, NY 14425, on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 9:00 AM and 3:30 PM; or online through internet based construction information subscription services.

The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Town of Farmington, nor Engineer, nor Avalon will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

The Town of Farmington, Ontario County, NY, reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or to waive any informalities, or to make an award to other than the low bidder. It further reserves the right to limit the amount of the award.

Attention of the bidders is particularly directed to the requirements of the conditions of employment to be observed and minimum Wage Rates to be paid under the Contract.

The Town of Farmington does not discriminate on the basis of handicapped status in admission or access to, or treatment or employment in, its programs and activities.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on October 10, 2019 at 1:00 PM local time at Town Hall Park Pavilion, County Road #8, Farmington NY. Representatives of Owner and Engineer will be present to discuss the Project. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.
